# Leadership Message

What an incredible time to be part of your Foundation! We hope to continue to work with you and your Lions Club in 2013-14 through these efforts:

- The Mobile Health Screening Program (MHSP) has doubled the number of children screened this year – 52,000! – and will continue to grow with your help. We're pleased to have reduced MHSP event fees to \$100 for school events and \$150 for community events. Contact Mara Steen at mara.steen@orlions.org for MHSP scheduling information.
- The first six months of the Lions Eyeglass Assistance Program (LEAP) has provided almost 2,300 gift certificates for free eye exams and eyeglasses for adults in need. LEAP has saved Lions Clubs an estimated \$250,000, and will save Clubs over \$500,000 annually as more Lions Clubs and Vision Service Plan (VSP) Providers join us. Thank you to everyone for making this program as success!
- The Foundation is the new partner of All American Hearing and Lions Clubs can now provide free hearing exams and free BRAND NEW hearing aids through 12 All American Hearing locations in Brookings, Medford, Roseburg, Eugene (2), Salem (2), McMinnville, Portland (3) and Redmond. Contact Kerith at kerith.vance@orlions.org today to learn more about "ROAR!", this great new program to help people hear the world around them!
- Our Mission Cataract team now has 23 surgeons throughout Oregon. Pioneered by Lion Dr. Jon-Marc Weston of Roseburg, Mission Cataract provides free cataract surgery and enables a local Lions Club to give the gift of sight at absolutely no cost. We will work to continue to grow Mission Cataract.
- These programs are showcased in OLSHF's new monthly Webinar Training series. To enhance communication and build relationships with Lions Clubs these free internet training experiences are for Lions to better access our programs. ## 2020 Vision Campaign Success

### The Next Generation of Mobile Health Screening

In May 2013, we reached our \$615,000 fundraising goal to expand our Mobile Health Screening Program. Over 52,000 people were screened this year alone—we have surpassed our goal of screening 50,000 children by 2016!

#### Campaign success is marked by:

- Twelve state-of-the-art sight and hearing screening kits in portable cases—for use at school and community events throughout the state. These kits enabled staff to screen over 1,000 children a day during multiple screenings this past fall.
- The purchase of five fuel-efficient branded vehicles to facilitate multiple screening events statewide on any given day.
- New partnerships with schools, including the screening of 12,000 students in the 34 Beaverton School District elementary schools.
- The hiring and training of part-time staff to help current staff screen, coordinate events, and manage inventory.

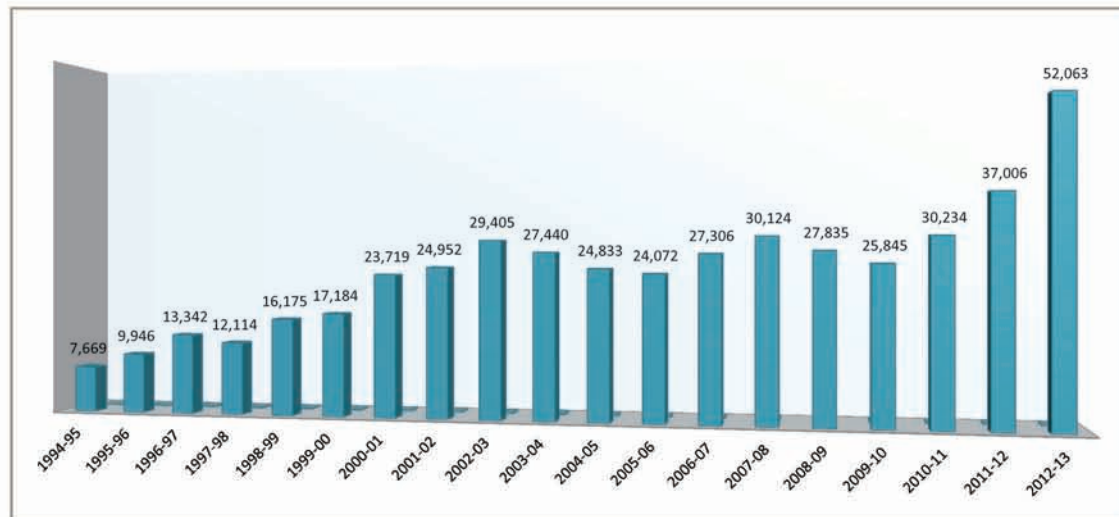

### PediaVision SPOT Enhances School Screenings

Twenty new hand-held PediaVision SPOT photo screening devices bring advanced technology to our Mobile Health Screening Program.

Screening each child takes seconds, not minutes! Our new SPOTs enhance our current sight and hearing screening kits with technology that ensures we catch any potential vision problems. It also eliminates communication barriers with non-English speaking students, special needs and pre-verbal children while minimizing disruption to classroom learning time.

Mobile Health Screening Program Event Manager Wally Anderson loves the efficient SPOT devices. "We found that we were screening an average of about 20 kids every 15 minutes. That's [for both] vision and hearing!"

## LEAP Takes Oregon Lions Clubs to New Heights

For decades, Oregon Lions Clubs spent hundreds of thousands of dollars each year providing eye exams and eyeglasses to low-income people in Oregon and Northern California. In January 2013, OLSHF launched the Lions Eyeglass Assistance Program (LEAP). In partnership with Vision Service Plan and Prevent Blindness America, LEAP is estimated to have saved Oregon Lions Clubs over \$260,000 in only six months. At no cost, it has provided gift certificates for eye exams and eyeglasses for almost 2,300 adults in need. Reaching all these people would not be possible without the dedicated efforts of Lions Clubs volunteers statewide.

This new effort will enable us to help the thousands who were previously turned away due to lack of funding and reach new heights in serving our communities.

## New Hearing Aid Partnership Will Make Lions ROAR!

The ROAR Hearing Aid Assistance Program is the newest addition to our services, launching July 1. All American Hearing chose OLSHF as its exclusive charitable partner, donating free exams, digital hearing aids, fittings and warranties to qualified applicants.



Hearing loss is the number one disability in the world, affecting approximately 31 million Americans. For most insured adults and families, coverage does not include the cost of hearing aids, which average over \$2,000 each. Now pre-approved Oregonians can access this program in their communities, including Aloha, Brookings, Clackamas, Eugene, Happy Valley, McMinnville, Medford, Portland, Redmond, Roseburg, Salem and Springfield. Lions Clubs volunteers will work with OLSHF to qualify individuals.

ROAR is yet another way Lions Clubs can save resources while serving more people in their communities.

## New OLSHF Eyeglass Recycling Center

In 2013, OLSHF began leasing a 2,000 square foot warehouse and office space for our Lions Eyeglass Recycling Center (LERC). For decades, OLSHF relied on donated space for storing donated and mission ready inventory, boxes and supplies. This new site has already improved our recycling efforts and houses over 100,000 pairs of eyeglasses, which volunteers sort during eyeglasses sorting parties held at the center. The OLSHF LERC is one of only 18 in the world.

## “Keep the Promise” Campaign

The Foundation successfully conducted its 1<sup>st</sup> Annual “Keep the Promise” campaign in May–June 2013 to support the Patient Care program, which provided sight and hearing surgery and treatments for over 200 Oregonians in need over the past 12 months. “Keep the Promise”—a tribute to the promise Lions made to Helen Keller to take up her cause—kicked off with the annual Patient Care Fundraising Breakfast at The Oregon Zoo on May 1<sup>st</sup> and culminated on June 27<sup>th</sup>—Helen Keller’s birthday—in the Healing Garden at Legacy Good Samaritan Hospital. The Joseph E. Weston Public Foundation helped propel the campaign in May with a \$20,000 challenge grant and the McMinnville Lions finished off the campaign with a \$1,500 gift on June 26<sup>th</sup>. As of the end of June the first “Keep the Promise” campaign had raised \$76,100!

**Currently only 1 out of 3 Patient Care applications can be approved due to available funding. These donors are helping us “Keep the Promise” to combat preventable blindness and deafness for people in need.**

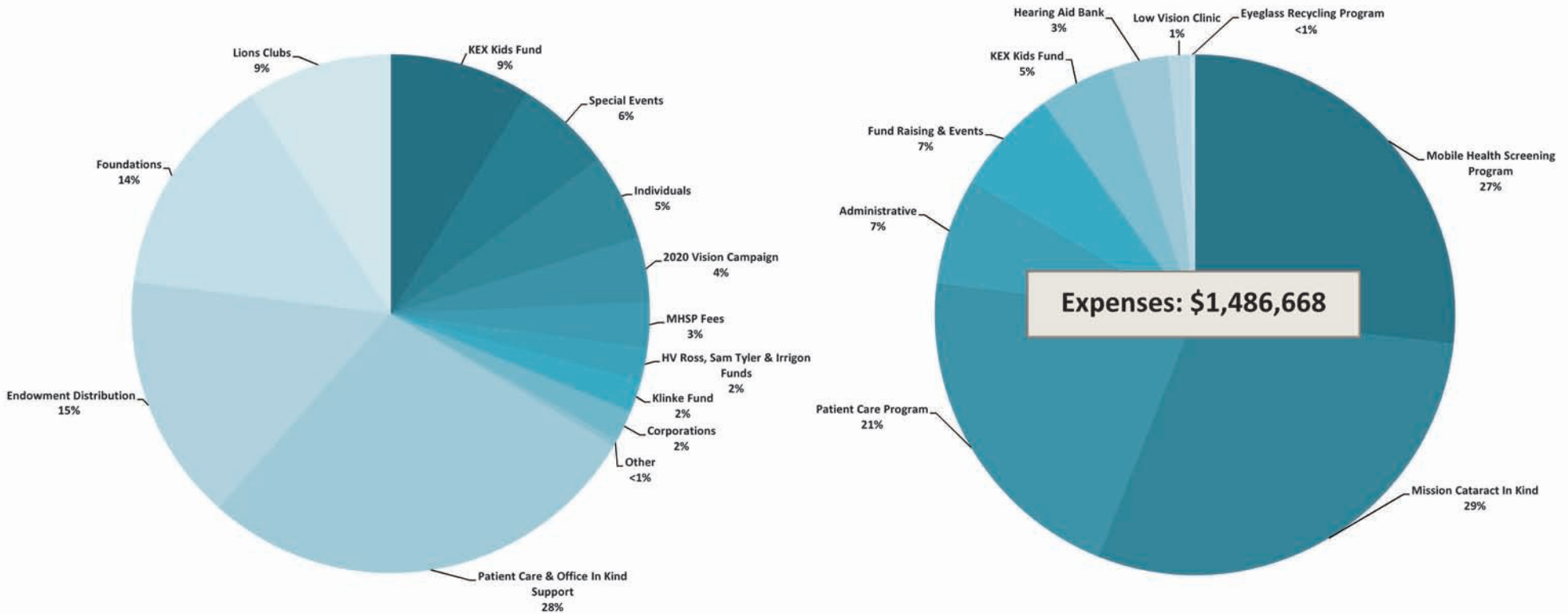
